Dates to Remember

Sept. 17 - Oct. 30: Registered voters may vote absentee or Early In-Person from 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Mon.-Fri.

*A locality may choose to start on Sept. 18 for its first day for early voting; otherwise, it begins Sept. 17.

Oct. 12: Last day to register or update your registration.

Oct. 22: Last day to request a mail-in absentee ballot.

Oct. 30: Last day to return an absentee ballot .

Virginia Department of Elections (ELECT) Voters can find the most current and complete source of information about elections and voting in Virginia on the Virginia Department of Elections website, elections.virginia.gov.

Register to Vote

You are eligible to register to vote if you are:

- a citizen of the United States; and
- a resident of Virginia; and
- at least 18 years of age on or before the next November General Election day; and
- not registered or planning to register in another state; and
- have had your voting rights restored if convicted of a felony or judged mentally incapacitated.

Online: You may register to vote online if you have a valid Virginia driver's license or print an application at elections.virginia.gov. Spanish, Vietnamese and Korean options are available to print.

In-Person: Register at your local registrar's office or DMV. Voter registration is accepted year-round.

How & Where to Vote

In Virginia, there are three options for casting your ballot:

In-Person Voting on Election Day

- Find your polling place at elections.virginia.gov
- Polling places are open from 6:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m.; you can vote if you are in line by 7:00 p.m.
- You must show an ID. Find acceptable forms of identification at elections.virginia.gov.
- Accessible equipment or curbside voting is available upon request.

Early Voting In-Person

- In Virginia, you do not need a reason to vote early.
- Vote early at your registrar's office or satellite voting location from Sept. 17 - Oct. 30, 2021.
- Accessible equipment or curbside voting is available upon request.

Absentee Voting by Mail

- In Virginia, no reason for voting by absentee is needed. You can track and verify your absentee ballot status at [elections.virginia.gov/citizen portal](https://elections.virginia.gov/citizen-portal).

Absentee voting by mail is a two-step process:

1. Request an absentee ballot:

- Online elections.virginia.gov
- In-Person: Local registrar's office

2. Return completed ballot:

- Mail:* Ballot must be postmarked on or by Election day; no postage required.
- Return: Deliver ballot to registrar's office, official ballot drop box, or your precinct's polling place by 7 p.m. on Election Day.

*When completing your absentee ballot, it is very important to carefully read and follow the ballot instructions; sign and return it quickly to give the U.S. Post Office time to deliver. Questions? Contact your registrar's office for accurate information.

STAFFORD COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD

The School Board holds various types of meetings of the full board, all of which are open to the public:

Regular Board Meetings are typically held on the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month except July, August, November and December. In those months, there is only one meeting (usually on the second Tuesday). These meetings are normally held in the School Board chambers at 31 Stafford Avenue, Stafford, VA 22554, unless adopted otherwise by the School Board.

Special Called Board Meetings are occasionally called when there is a time-sensitive matter that must be discussed or voted upon before the next regularly scheduled meeting. These meetings are usually held in the School Board chambers.

Work Sessions are held when the Board needs to hold a lengthy, in-depth discussion on a particular matter. Votes are not taken during work sessions. Work sessions are usually held in the executive session room unless a larger venue is needed.

Public Hearings are held when a matter arises that requires citizen input (i.e., budgets, redistricting). The location of public hearings varies.

The meetings of the Stafford School Board are broadcast live at 7 p.m. on Comcast Cable Channel 18, Cox Channel 89, and Verizon Fios Channel 38. They are then re-broadcast in a taped version on Fridays at 7 p.m., on Saturdays at 1 p.m., and on the following Tuesdays at 7 p.m.
