## VIRGINIA GENERAL ELECTION November 8, 2022, 6 a.m. to 7 p.m.

You will be voting for: U.S. Congress Town Council members in Bowling Green and in Port Royal School board member in James Madison District, King George County If primaries are held, they will take place on June 21.

## **Dates to Remember**

**Sept. 23 - Nov. 5:** Registered voters may vote absentee or Early In-Person from 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Mon.-Fri.

Oct. 17: Last day to register or update your registration.

Oct. 28: Last day to request a mail-in absentee ballot.

Nov. 5: Last day to return an absentee ballot.

\*All election offices must be open the last two Saturdays before the November 8 general election.

#### Virginia Department of Elections (ELECT)

Voters can find the most current and complete source of information about elections and voting in Virginia on the Virginia Department of Elections website, elections.virginia.gov.

## **Register to Vote**

You are eligible to register to vote if you are:

- a citizen of the United States; and
- a resident of Virginia; and
- at least 18 years of age on or before the next November General Election day; and
- not registered or planning to register in another state; and
- have had your voting rights restored if convicted of a felony or judged mentally incapacitated.

**Online:** You may register to vote online if you have a valid Virginia driver's license or print an application at elections.virginia.gov. Spanish, Vietnamese and Korean options are available to print.

**In-Person:** Register at your local registrar's office or DMV. Voter registration is accepted year-round.

## **How & Where to Vote**

In Virginia, there are three options for casting your ballot:

#### **In-Person Voting on Election Day**

- Find your polling place at elections.virginia.gov.
- Polling places are open from 6:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m.; you can vote if you are in line by 7:00 p.m.
- You must show an ID. Find acceptable forms of identification at elections. virginia.gov.
- Accessible equipment or curbside voting is available upon request.

#### Early Voting In-Person

- In Virginia, you do not need a reason to vote early.
- Vote early at your registrar's office or satellite voting location from Sept. 23 Nov. 5, 2022.
- Accessible equipment or curbside voting is available upon request.

#### Absentee Voting by Mail

 In Virginia, no reason for voting absentee is needed. You can track and verify your absentee ballot status at elections.virginia.gov/citizen portal.

Absentee voting by mail is a two-step process:

- 1. Request an absentee ballot:
- Online elections.virginia.gov
- In-Person: Local registrar's office
- 2. Return completed ballot:
- Mail:\* Ballot must be postmarked on or by Election Day; no postage required.
- Return: Deliver ballot to registrar's office, official ballot drop box, or your precinct's polling place by 7 p.m. on Election Day.

\*When completing your absentee ballot, it is very important to carefully read and follow the ballot instructions; sign and return it quickly to give the U.S. Post Office time to deliver. Questions? Contact your registrar's office for accurate information.
